

Medical Cannabis in Clinical Practice

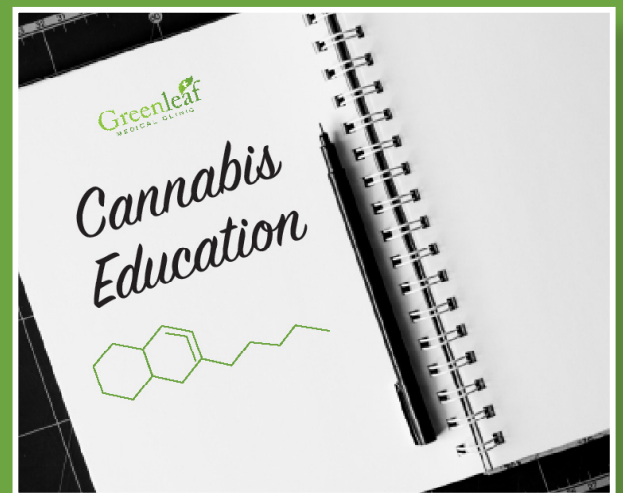
Preceptorship Training Program for Physicians and Nurse Practitioners

There is a demand for medical cannabis education amongst Health Care Practitioners, as more Physicians and Nurse Practitioners are open to prescribing medical cannabis to their patients. However, some physicians are unsure of how to appropriately navigate the Access to Cannabis for Medical Purpose Regulation (ACMPR).

The Greenleaf Medical Clinic, has developed a Preceptorship Training Program designed as an educational platform for Health Care Practitioners. This one or two day program will provide access to hands on clinical training in medical cannabis.
