ARE THERE LONG-TERM EFFECTS TO CANNABIS USE?

Canadians are now able to legally purchase cannabis for recreational use in their communities. But, despite its widespread availability, there's very little known about the long-term physical, psychological and social effects of cannabis.

The data collected in this study will allow researchers involved in DataCann to begin to look for answers to questions such as, what conditions is cannabis is being used for, what are the possible benefits and risks and what education should be available to people with chronic non-cancer pain using or considering using cannabis for medical purposes. Ultimately the hope is that the data collected in this study will impact healthcare guidelines and prescribing practices to ensure the best outcomes for people with chronic non-cancer pain using cannabis for medical purposes.
