




How to start & increase dried flower





What dose am I currently taking in mgs?



Calculate your dose:

Conc. = 10 mgs/ml x 0.50 ml = 5 mgs THC & 5 mgs CBD

 The lesser of 150 grams or a 30-day supply of dried cannabis (or the equivalent in cannabis product) in addition to the 30 grams allowed for non-medical purposes
